**NORTH CAROLINA BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS REFERRAL SYSTEM (BH-CRSys)**

Offered through the NC Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services, the Behavioral Health Crisis Referral System (BH-CRSys) is a new secure on-line tool that will be available to facilities across North Carolina that routinely encounter behavioral health patients in crisis and facilities that can assess and treat these individuals. Available statewide by the end of December 2017, BH-CRSys features include: detailed facility information, criteria-based placement search, system-based initiation and notification of referrals and internal communication features. **DISABILITY DETERMINATION SERVICES - Raleigh, NC**

The NC Disability Determination Services is responsible for adjudicating claims filed for disability benefits under Title II (Social Security Disability Income) and Title XVI (Supplemental Security Income) of the Social Security Act for residents of North Carolina. If applicants do not have a treating source (physician, clinic, or hospital), or if the medical reports from treating sources are inadequate or incomplete, then the Disability Determination Services may purchase a consultative examination(s) from other physicians or psychologists. Psychologists willing to perform psychological evaluations on these applicants are a vital link in the disability adjudication process. For more information call: **800.443.9360**.
