Why participate?

- Submissions are reviewed by individuals with research experience
- Posters are seen and reviewed by psychologists interested in your work
- Gain experience in presenting your research to others
- Meet student researchers from other universities and learn about their work
- Show graduate schools and potential employers your research interest and motivation
- Build your curriculum vitae

Abstract must include the following information to be considered:

- Title of research
- Date of IRB or IACUC Approval
- Poster category (graduate or undergraduate)
- Name of student author(s)
- Name of university or college
- Contact person: Name, mailing address, phone number, and email address
- Faculty sponsor or supervisor: Name, email address, and phone number
- 300 Word (maximum) Abstract: Must Include: Introduction, Method, Results, and Discussion sections

*Note: Data analysis **MUST** be completed by submission in order for poster to be accepted.*

*Presenters are held to the same professional standard as APA.*

**Please submit your abstract by Friday, March 22, 2019.**

Must be:

- WORD document, 12 point font (Do not send as a PDF)
- Must be no more than 300 words
